
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE
LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU,
AND THE OMBUDSMAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for defraying any and all session
4 and nonsession expenses of the senate up to and including
5 June 30, 2010, including the 2009 regular session, twenty-fifth
6 legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and
7 the expenses of any committee or committees established during
8 the interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular sessions.

9 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
10 the senate.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for defraying any and all session
14 and nonsession expenses of the house of representatives up to
15 and including June 30, 2010, including the 2009 regular session,
16 twenty-fifth legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session
17 expenses and the expenses of any committee or committees



1 established during the interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular
2 sessions.

3 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
4 the house of representatives.

5 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the senate during the
6 interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular sessions shall be made
7 only with the approval of the president of the senate, and
8 payment of expenses of the house of representatives during the
9 interim between the 2009 and 2010 regular sessions shall be made
10 only with the approval of the speaker of the house of
11 representatives.

12 SECTION 4. Before January 20, 2010, the senate and the
13 house of representatives shall each have their accounts audited,
14 and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to
15 the senate and to the house of representatives convening on
16 January 20, 2010.

17 SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the
18 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad
19 on official business of the legislature shall be \$145 a day as
20 authorized by the president of the senate and the speaker of the
21 house of representatives, respectively.



1 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the
4 following expenses:

5 (1) The sum of \$ for defraying the expenses of the
6 office of the auditor during fiscal year 2009-2010;

7 (2) The sum of \$ for defraying the expenses of the
8 office of the state ethics commission during fiscal
9 year 2009-2010; and

10 (3) The sum of \$ during fiscal year 2009-2010 for:

11 (A) Performing special studies;

12 (B) Improving capabilities for planning, programming,
13 and budgeting;

14 (C) Fulfilling other special requests made of the
15 auditor by the legislature or jointly by the
16 president of the senate and the speaker of the
17 house of representatives;

18 (D) Legislative studies and contractual services for
19 those studies; and

20 (E) Such other purposes as may be determined by the
21 joint action of the president of the senate and
22 the speaker of the house of representatives.



1 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
2 the auditor.

3 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor during
6 fiscal year 2009-2010 to be deposited into the audit revolving
7 fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii Revised
8 Statutes.

9 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the audit
10 revolving fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary to the office of the auditor during fiscal year 2009-
12 2010 for the auditor to conduct or complete its audit functions
13 as provided by law.

14 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
15 the auditor.

16 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
18 thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau
19 for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau
20 during fiscal year 2009-2010, including equipment relating to
21 computer systems programming and operations.



1 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
2 the legislative reference bureau.

3 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for
6 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year
7 2009-2010.

8 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
9 the ombudsman.

10 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for defraying the expenses of the
13 legislative information system:

14 (1) \$900,000 to the senate; and

15 (2) \$900,000 to the house of representatives.

16 This appropriation shall be used to pay for hardware, software,
17 consultants, installation, materials, supplies, and other
18 related costs associated with the legislative information system
19 that have been or will be incurred.

20 The sums appropriated in this section shall be expended by
21 the senate and the house of representatives, respectively.

1 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for the legislative broadcast
4 program, including the production and distribution of television
5 broadcasts of legislative proceedings.

6 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
7 the legislature for the purposes of this section.


8 SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund,
9 as of the close of business on June 30, 2010, the unexpended or
10 unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall
11 lapse into the general fund.

12 SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be
13 severable from the remainder of this Act.

14 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
