## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH BENEFITS TRUST  
FUND.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 87A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§87A-       Rules; dependent-beneficiaries; military  
5 deployment. The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91  
6 that provide for the extension of health benefits coverage for a  
7 dependent-beneficiary who is an unmarried child of an employee-  
8 beneficiary and over the age of twenty-four; provided that:

9           (1) The dependent-beneficiary was a member of a reserve  
10           component of the United States armed forces and was  
11           ordered to active duty in federal service while the  
12           dependent-beneficiary was a full-time student under  
13           the age of twenty-four; and

14           (2) The extended health benefits coverage provided under  
15           this section shall be limited to the time period  
16           during which the dependent-beneficiary is on active  
17           duty pursuant to paragraph (1)."



- 1 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
