
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 287-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) The traffic violations bureaus of the district
4 courts, upon request, shall furnish any person a certified
5 abstract of the bureaus' record, if any, of any person relating
6 to [~~all-alleged~~] convictions or civil judgments for moving
7 violations [~~and any convictions resulting therefrom,~~] arising
8 from the operation of a motor vehicle and any administrative
9 license revocation pursuant to chapter 291E, part III and
10 chapter 286, part XIV, as it was in effect on or before
11 December 31, 2001. The traffic violations bureaus may collect a
12 fee, not to exceed \$7, of which \$5 shall be deposited into the
13 general fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the judiciary
14 computer system special fund."

15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
16 matured before its effective date but shall apply to proceedings
17 that were begun before its effective date but not concluded
18 until after its effective date.



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2009.
