
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS STATEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The disclosure of financial interest required by this
4 section shall be filed:

5 (1) [~~Between~~] By an employee between January 1 and May 31
6 of each year;

7 (2) By a legislator between January 1 and January 31 of
8 each year; provided that if a legislator is unable to
9 provide the amount of income from any particular
10 source of income required by subsection (f)(1) by
11 January 31, the legislator shall make a good faith
12 estimate of the amount of income from the source of
13 income by January 31;

14 [~~+2~~] (3) Within thirty days of one's election or
15 appointment to a state position enumerated in
16 subsection (c); or

17 [~~+3~~] (4) Within thirty days of separation from a state
18 position if a prior financial disclosure statement for



1 the position was not filed within the one hundred
2 eighty days preceding the date of separation;
3 provided that candidates for state elective offices or the
4 constitutional convention shall file the required statements no
5 later than twenty days prior to the date of the primary election
6 for state offices or the election of delegates to the
7 constitutional convention."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
