# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING CASTLE & COOKE HAWAII, INC. TO WORK WITH THE OAHU  
ARTS CENTER AND THE COMMUNITY TO SECURE AN APPROPRIATE SITE  
FOR AN ARTS CENTER.

1           WHEREAS, arts education promotes the successful development  
2 of young children and the celebration of arts helps bring  
3 families and communities together; and

5           WHEREAS, Central Oahu, Leeward Oahu, and the North Shore,  
6 among Hawaii's fastest growing communities, desire to promote  
7 and encourage the love of the arts by supporting an arts  
8 education center and performing arts theater in Central Oahu to  
9 be known as the Oahu Arts Center (Center); and

11           WHEREAS, the Center would provide for community members of  
12 all ages with arts education and an opportunity to participate  
13 in art activities throughout the year; and

15           WHEREAS, the Center would provide a state-of-the-art  
16 facility to showcase, not only the talent and work of local  
17 artists in every medium, as well as the artistry of national and  
18 international musicians and artists; and

20           WHEREAS, development of the Center would help stimulate  
21 economic development of local communities and businesses by  
22 generating community participation in the Center, creating jobs  
23 for those constructing and working at the Center, and attracting  
24 tourists and residents to the events to be featured at the  
25 Center; and

27           WHEREAS, Castle & Cooke, Inc. has reportedly committed to  
28 donating three acres of land in Mililani Mauka for the  
29 development of the Center in the past; now, therefore,

31           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
32 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
33 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that Castle & Cooke Hawaii,



1 Inc., is requested to work together with the Oahu Arts Center  
2 and the community to secure an appropriate site for an arts  
3 center; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
6 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the  
7 members of Hawaii's congressional delegation, the Mayor of the  
8 City and County of Honolulu, the Council Chair of the City and  
9 County of Honolulu, and the President of Castle & Cooke Hawaii,
