
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS ON REASONABLE
RESTRICTIONS ON FLYING THE UNITED STATES AND STATE FLAG
WITHIN PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS AND CONDOMINIUMS.

1 WHEREAS, a flag is one of the most widely employed and
2 recognizable symbols used to represent a nation, entity, or
3 organization; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the Flag of the United States of America, or
6 American Flag, is one such symbol that represents the ideals
7 that were used to establish this country, including those of
8 life, liberty, equality, and the pursuit of happiness; and
9

10 WHEREAS, the American Flag is frequently displayed, not
11 only on public buildings, but on private residences, and is also
12 used as a motif on decals for car windows and on clothing
13 ornaments such as badges and lapel pins; and
14

15 WHEREAS, the display of, and respect for, the American Flag
16 as a symbol of the United States of America holds such
17 importance that guidelines for the use, display, and disposal of
18 the flag are codified in various Titles of the United States
19 Code, including Title 4, Title 18, and Title 36; and

21 WHEREAS, respect and display protocols exist for numerous
22 flags around the world, including state flags and international
23 flags; and

25 WHEREAS, community associations are often charged with
26 duties that include developing rules and regulations to preserve
27 the aesthetic conditions of the entire community, which at times
28 may involve establishing restrictions on the display of flags in
29 the community; and

1 WHEREAS, these restrictions have resulted in emotional
2 situations to which compromises need to be found that preserve
3 the aesthetic quality of a planned community while allowing for
4 the reasonable display of flags; now, therefore,
5

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
7 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
8 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that there is hereby established
9 a task force (Task Force), to be placed within the State
10 Department of Defense for administrative purposes only, to draft
11 recommendations on reasonable restrictions and protocols for the
12 respectful display of the United States and State flag by
13 homeowners belonging to a planned community association and
14 condominium association; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Task Force shall be
17 composed of members representing the State Department of Defense
18 or the Veterans' Administration, various veterans organizations,
19 community associations, and homeowners belonging to community
20 associations; and
21

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Adjutant General of the
23 State of Hawaii, or the Veterans' Administration, shall serve as
24 chair of the Task Force, shall select the members of the Task
25 Force, and shall report the findings and recommendations of the
26 Task Force, including any proposed legislation, to the
27 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the
28 Regular Session of 2012; and

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Adjutant General,
32 State Department of Defense, and the Veterans' Administration.
