
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HIGH TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO
COORDINATE INITIATIVES WITHIN THE COMMUNITY WHICH ADDRESS
ENERGY INNOVATION WITH THE ORGANIZERS OF ENERGY AWARDS AND
PROGRAMS, AND ASSIST IN THEIR OUTREACH TO THE HAWAII
COMMUNITY.

1 WHEREAS, a strong, diversified economy is essential to the
2 well-being of the State of Hawaii; and

4 WHEREAS, several venues of honoring and assisting
5 innovation already exist within the Hawaii community; and

7 WHEREAS, the State should encourage innovation within the
8 commercial high technology industry sector for the State to
9 remain productive and withstand the changes and challenges of
10 the 21st century economy; and

12 WHEREAS, in 2005, the Legislature created the High
13 Technology Development Corporation (HTDC) to assist in the
14 diversification of the State's economy by facilitating the
15 growth and development of the commercial high technology
16 industry; and

18 WHEREAS, HTDC is concerned with the health of Hawaii's
19 natural environment and is dedicated to creating designs and
20 projects that increase sustainability and use energy-saving
21 techniques; and

23 WHEREAS, the State supports innovative persons, projects
24 and companies that incorporate energy-saving techniques, and the
25 State recognizes that this is crucial to sustaining and
26 promoting growth within Hawaii's commercial high technology
27 industry sector and is beneficial to the state economy,
28 environment, and our global community; now, therefore,



1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
2 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
3 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that HTDC is requested to
4 coordinate initiatives within the community which address energy
5 innovation with the organizers of energy awards and programs,
6 and assist in their outreach to the Hawaii community; and
