
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU FOR ITS OUTSTANDING SERVICE IN REDUCING THE BACKLOG OF MUCH NEEDED STREET REPAIRS AND REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CONTINUE WITH STREET REPAVEMENT, REPAIRS, AND TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE REPAIR AND REPAVING OF SIDE STREETS ALONG KALIHI STREET.

1 WHEREAS, in recent years, the poor condition of Honolulu's
2 streets has been widely criticized; and
3

4 WHEREAS, streets have fallen into a state of disrepair,
5 thereby presenting a safety risk to children, kupuna, and all
6 pedestrians, and causing anguish to drivers and sometimes damage
7 to vehicles; and
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9 WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu (C&C) has
10 taken great strides to clear the backlog of much-needed street
11 repairs and repaving, some areas are still in need of remedial
12 attention; and
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14 WHEREAS, from Kalihi Uka Elementary School through Kalihi
15 Valley, children walk to and from school on roadways with no
16 sidewalks, or they cross streets without pedestrian lights; and

18 WHEREAS, one of these areas is Kalihi, where numerous side
19 streets are in need of repair and repaving; now, therefore,
20

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
23 of 2010, the Senate concurring, that C&C is requested to conduct
24 a feasibility study for the repair and repaving of side streets
25 along Kalihi Street and to address major concerns along Kalihi
26 Street; and
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28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the feasibility study focus
29 specifically on:
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
- 1 (1) Widening, through eminent domain, Kalihi Street,
- 2 beginning from Kalihi Uka Elementary School to Kalihi
- 3 Valley Park at the end of Kalihi Valley;
- 4
- 5 (2) Construction to resolve safety concerns on a blind
- 6 curve along the 3100 block of Kalihi Street known as
- 7 the "S curve;"
- 8
- 9 (3) Construction of sidewalks along the section of Kalihi
- 10 Street described in item (1);
- 11
- 12 (4) Removing telephone poles along the section of Kalihi
- 13 Street described in item (1) and, instead, placing
- 14 electrical and telecommunications wires underground;
- 15
- 16 (5) Adding more accessible bus service in Kalihi Valley
- 17 for certain streets, which may lack access to bus
- 18 service; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study focuses specifically
 21 on Kilohana Street, Waialele Street, Ahihi Street, Murphy Street,
 22 Merkle Street, Noe Street, Laulani Street, Pahulu Street, Wahine
 23 Place, Anuu Place, Manaiki Place, Akone Place, Mahani Loop,
 24 Kuikele Street, Papali Place, Violet Street, Numana Road,
 25 Puolani Street, Ha'aliki Street, Ukiuki Place, Monte Street,
 26 Kalaepa'a Drive, Kuapapa Place, Kale Place, Kui Place, Waho
 27 Place, Ahuahu Place, Huea Place, Umalua Place, Moani Street, and
 28 Kapali Street; and

 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that C&C is requested to submit a
 31 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no
 32 later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session
 33 of 2011; and

 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 36 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City
 37 and County of Honolulu and neighborhood board 16.
