## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES THAT WOULD REZONE MAUNALUA BAY AND DEMARCATATE THE ZONES MORE VISIBLY TO IMPROVE SAFETY.

1           WHEREAS, Maunalua Bay is becoming an increasingly popular  
2 area for watercraft recreation, sustenance gathering, and ocean  
3 based commercial enterprises; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, currently in the State of Hawaii there are  
6 approximately fifteen thousand registered vessels; and  
7

8           WHEREAS, of those registered vessels 1,330 are considered  
9 thrill craft/personal water craft; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, with this increased unregulated activity comes  
12 greater instances of conflicts between the various types of  
13 users of the bay; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, these accidents can result in grave consequences  
16 as seen in the tragic October death of 17 year old Keahihoku Lum  
17 who was killed when a speedboat ran over him along with his buoy  
18 and diving flag in Maunalua Bay; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, clearly demarcated zoning of Maunalua Bay would  
21 provide increased overall safety for all users as well as  
22 decrease verbal and physical conflict between those users; and  
23

24           WHEREAS, clearly identified zones for users such as divers,  
25 personal water craft users, ocean based business operators,  
26 swimmers and surfers would not only allow for increased safety  
27 but also for increased enjoyment without having to fear  
28 altercation or accident; and

30           WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources is  
31 the appropriate agency to develop and oversee such zoning to



1 provide for the health and safety of users of Maunalua Bay; now,  
2 therefore,

3  
4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
5 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
6 of 2010, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is  
7 urged to adopt administrative rules rezoning Maunalua Bay  
8 creating clearly demarcated zones for use; and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
11 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor of Hawaii and  
12 Chairperson of the Department of Land and Natural Resources.
