
HOUSE RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING POLICIES FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BROADCAST PROGRAM'S CABLECASTS OF HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES' PROCEEDINGS.

1 WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program, which was
2 established and began cable casting House of Representatives'
3 proceedings on a pilot basis in 1994, and has been renewed every
4 session since then; and

5
6 WHEREAS, Act 373, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, codified as
7 chapter 21G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to public access,
8 established the legislative broadcast program; and

9
10 WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program produces live
11 and tape-delayed video broadcasts of selected legislative
12 proceedings for cable casting on public-education-government
13 access channels and video casting on the Internet; and

14
15 WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program is intended to
16 increase public access, to and participation in, the legislative
17 process; and

19 WHEREAS, 'Olelo Community Television continues to provide
20 the Legislature with technical and engineering support,
21 programming time for cablecasts, broadcast production television
22 equipment, and preventive maintenance, repair, and replacement
23 as needed; and

25 WHEREAS, a private broadcast production company is
26 currently contracted by the Legislature to produce broadcasts of
27 legislative proceedings; and

29 WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency, reliability, and
30 responsibility for programming, the House of Representatives
31 finds it necessary to establish policies to govern the
32 participation in the legislative broadcast program; now,
33 therefore,



1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
2 Twenty-fifth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
3 of 2010, that the following policies shall govern the activities
4 of the legislative broadcast program as it pertains to the House
5 of Representatives:

- 7 (1) Project Responsibility: The content, selection, and
8 editorial policies shall be administered by the
9 Speaker of the House of Representatives or the
10 Speaker's designee. 'Olelo Community Television shall
11 provide technical and engineering support, programming
12 time for cablecasts, broadcast production television
13 equipment, and preventive maintenance, repair, and
14 replacement as needed;

- 16 (2) Distribution: Cablecast programming coverage and
17 distribution shall be provided by 'Olelo Community
18 Television on O'ahu; by Akaku: Maui Community
19 Television on Maui, Moloka'i, and Lana'i; by Ho'ike:
20 Kaua'i Community Television on Kaua'i; and by Na Leo 'O
21 Hawai'i, Inc., on Hawai'i. All bona fide news
22 organizations and educational institutions shall be
23 authorized to utilize the programming material and
24 shall bear costs associated with the programming.
25 Campaign or commercial uses of material distributed by
26 the Speaker's designee or the legislative contractor
27 are prohibited;

- 29 (3) Programming Content: Programming shall include live
30 and tape-delayed cablecasts. All public committee
31 hearings, legislative sessions, and other legislative
32 proceedings shall be authorized for programming and
33 selected by the Speaker of the House of
34 Representatives or the Speaker's designee. In
35 addition, the Speaker or the Speaker's designee may
36 authorize special programming. Programming material
37 distributed by the Speaker's designee or the
38 legislative contractor shall not be used for campaign
39 or commercial purposes;

- 41 (4) Editing: Cablecasts of legislative proceedings shall
42 be covered gavel-to-gavel, and shall include coverage
43 of the speaker recognized by the chair or presiding



1 officer. Occasional shots of the entire committee or
2 assembled body shall be allowed; however, close-up
3 "reaction" shots shall not be permitted; and

- 5 (5) Ownership and Use of Programming: Tapes and
6 cablecasts shall be considered the property of the
7 House of Representatives. Tapes and cablecasts shall
8 not be considered an official record of the meeting,
9 and there shall be no liability for inadvertent
10 erasure or omission. Tapes of proceedings shall be
11 retained at least for a period of time necessary for
12 rebroadcasts on neighbor island cable systems, and for
13 use in program evaluation and staff training; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
16 Resolution be transmitted to the Speaker of the House of
17 Representatives, House Majority Leader, House Minority Leader,
18 'Olelo Community Television, Akaku: Maui Community Television,
19 Ho'ike: Kaua'i Community Television, Na Leo 'O Hawai'i, Inc., and
20 Oceanic Time Warner Cable of Hawaii.
