14 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 15 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 16 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 17 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 18 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

19 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 20 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 21 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act;
 22 provided that:

- 1 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 4 shall be
2 expended by the department of education; and
3 (2) The sums appropriated in items 5 through 7 shall be
4 expended by the University of Hawaii.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
