A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part X to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§103D-Preference for employers of individuals with
- 5 disabilities and recipients of temporary assistance to needy
- families. (a) When a governmental body contracts for goods, 6
- 7 services, or construction, a preference shall be given to a
- 8 bidder who pledges to hire individuals with disabilities or
- 9 recipients of temporary assistance to needy families; provided
- 10 that the individuals with disabilities and recipients of
- 11 temporary assistance to needy families are employed for the
- 12 duration of the contract.
- 13 The preference amount shall be equal to the percentage
- of individuals employed by the bidder who are individuals with 14
- 15 disabilities or recipients of temporary assistance to needy
- 16 families and shall be subtracted from the offer for selection
- 17 purposes only; provided that the preference amount shall not

1	exceed twenty-five per cent of the bid price; provided further
2	that part-time employees who are individuals with disabilities
3	or recipients of temporary assistance to needy families shall be
4	counted in proportion to the number of hours they work in a
5	forty hour work week.
6	(c) The department of human services shall establish a
7	registry of individuals with disabilities and recipients of
. 8	temporary assistance to needy families who are seeking
9	employment that a bidder may use to fulfill the pledge under
10	subsection (a).
11	(d) For the purposes of this section, "individual with
12	disability" means an individual who has a physical or mental
13	impairment that substantially limits one or more major life
14	activities, including an individual who the department of human
15	services, the department of health, or a physician licensed
16	under chapter 453 determines to be disabled."
17	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
