A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$94,772,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 thirteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kuakini street extension project

8 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
11 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
12 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
14 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
15 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
16 follows:

- 17 (1) For item 1, the expending agency shall be the
18 department of transportation;
- 19 (2) For item 2, the expending agency shall be the Hawaii
20 Health Systems Corporation; and
- 21 (3) For items 3 through 17, the expending agency shall be
22 the department of education.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
