A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVANCED FLIGHT SIMULATOR TRAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 209E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "qualified business" to
3 read as follows:

4 ""Qualified business" means any corporation, partnership,
5 or sole proprietorship authorized to do business in the State
6 that is qualified under section 209E-9, subject to the state
7 corporate or individual income tax under chapter 235, and is:

8 (1) Engaged in manufacturing, the wholesale sale of
9 tangible personal property as defined in section 237-
10 4, or a service business as defined in this chapter;

11 (2) Engaged in producing agricultural products where the
12 business is a producer as defined in section 237-5, or
13 engaged in processing agricultural products, all or
14 some of which were grown within an enterprise zone;

15 (3) Engaged in research, development, sale, or production
16 of all types of genetically-engineered medical,
17 agricultural, or maritime biotechnology products; [ex]



1 (4) Engaged in producing electric power from wind energy
2 for sale primarily to a public utility company for
3 resale to the public[-]; or


4 (5) Engaged in advanced flight simulator training for
5 pilots, dispatchers, mechanics, or air traffic
6 controllers."

7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Enterprise Zones; Commercial Aviation Training

Description:

Adds businesses engaged in advanced flight simulator training for pilots, dispatchers, mechanics, or air traffic controllers to the definition of "qualified business" under the state enterprise zone law.
