# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 368-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
