# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN MUSIC AND DANCE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 **PART I.**

2 SECTION 1. Chapter 9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to  
4 read as follows:

5 **"§9- Museum for Hawaiian music and dance; advisory**

6 **committee; established.** (a) There is established the museum  
7 for Hawaiian music and dance. The museum for Hawaiian music and  
8 dance shall be placed within the state foundation on culture and  
9 the arts for administrative purposes.

10 (b) The foundation, in coordination with the department of  
11 accounting and general services, shall negotiate with a  
12 qualified nonprofit entity formed under section 501(c)(3) (with  
13 respect to exemption from tax on corporations, certain trusts,  
14 etc.) of the Internal Revenue Code to develop, operate, and  
15 manage the museum. The foundation and the department of  
16 accounting and general services may execute a contract to

1 develop, operate, and manage the museum. The contracted  
2 nonprofit entity shall be entitled to name the museum.

3 (c) The department of accounting and general services may  
4 construct the building and ancillary facilities for the museum  
5 for Hawaiian music and dance or negotiate and execute a contract  
6 to construct the building and ancillary facilities for the  
7 museum with the qualified nonprofit entity contracted under  
8 subsection (b). The department of land and natural resources or  
9 the Hawaii community development authority, as applicable, may  
10 lease land for the museum for Hawaiian music and dance to the  
11 contracted nonprofit entity for a nominal sum.

12 The foundation and the department of accounting and general  
13 services may negotiate with the Hawaii community development  
14 authority to identify an appropriate location in the Kakaako  
15 makai area on lands controlled by the Hawaii community  
16 development authority, in consultation with the design advisory  
17 committee established under subsection (e).

18 (d) The nonprofit entity contracted to develop, operate,  
19 and manage the museum for Hawaiian music and dance shall:

20 (1) Develop, operate, and manage the museum for Hawaiian  
21 music and dance as established in this section;

- 1        (2) Enter into contracts and leases as necessary for the  
2        location of the museum for Hawaiian music and dance,  
3        without regard to chapter 103D;
- 4        (3) Determine the type of institution that would be  
5        appropriate for the museum for Hawaiian music and  
6        dance;
- 7        (4) Determine the best location for the museum for  
8        Hawaiian music and dance; provided that more than one  
9        location shall be allowed;
- 10       (5) Determine a plan to incorporate the Hawaiian music  
11       hall of fame and museum into the museum for Hawaiian  
12       music and dance;
- 13       (6) Establish a Hawaiian dance hall of fame to be  
14       incorporated into the museum for Hawaiian music and  
15       dance; and
- 16       (7) Designate possible financing mechanisms for the museum  
17       for Hawaiian music and dance.
- 18       (e) The foundation shall establish an ad hoc design  
19       advisory committee, as may be necessary from time to time, to  
20       advise the contracted nonprofit entity of the museum for  
21       Hawaiian music and dance on all matters relevant to subsections  
22       (c) and (d). Members of the design advisory committee shall be

1 selected by the foundation from appropriate Hawaiian culture and  
2 art groups, and shall dissolve upon completion of the  
3 specifically assigned responsibilities of the design advisory  
4 committee."

5 **PART II.**

6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so  
8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 to  
9 finance the design and the environmental assessment relating to  
10 the construction of the building and ancillary facilities for  
11 the museum for Hawaiian music and dance.

12 The sum appropriated under this part shall be expended by  
13 the state foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of  
14 this Act.

15 **PART III.**

16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2090.
