# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE OFFICERS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law  
2 to the contrary, for the period from July 1, 2009 to June 30,  
3 2011, the salary paid to a state officer specified in subsection  
4 (b) shall be five per cent less than the annual salary amount  
5 that they would otherwise receive as provided for by law.

6           (b) For the purposes of this section, the term "state  
7 officer" means any of the following persons:


- 8           (1) The governor;
- 9           (2) The lieutenant governor;
- 10          (3) Members of the legislature;
- 11          (4) Justices and judges of all state courts;
- 12          (5) The administrative director of the State or an  
13             equivalent position; and
- 14          (6) Department heads or executive officers and the  
15             deputies or assistants to the department heads of the  
16             departments of:
  - 17                (A) Accounting and general services;
  - 18                (B) Agriculture;



- 1 (C) The attorney general;
- 2 (D) Budget and finance;
- 3 (E) Business, economic development, and tourism;
- 4 (F) Commerce and consumer affairs;
- 5 (G) Defense;
- 6 (H) Hawaiian home lands;
- 7 (I) Health;
- 8 (J) Human resources development;
- 9 (K) Human services;
- 10 (L) Labor and industrial relations;
- 11 (M) Land and natural resources;
- 12 (N) Public safety;
- 13 (O) Taxation; and
- 14 (P) Transportation;
- 15 provided that the term shall not include the president
- 16 of the University of Hawaii or the superintendent of
- 17 education.

18 SECTION 2. In the event of a conflict between this Act and  
 19 any other provision of law, this Act shall control.

20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
