A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to reflect the
2 transfer of responsibility for school facilities, including the
3 repair and maintenance of donated equipment and fixtures, from
4 the department of accounting and general services to the
5 department of education as provided for in Act 51, Session Laws
6 of Hawaii 2004.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1501, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 9 "(b) In any case where air conditioners are installed in a
10 particular school, the department may require that the
11 approximate cost of electricity and maintenance for air
12 conditioners not installed by the department [~~of accounting and~~
13 ~~general services~~] be paid by a private entity until the
14 department establishes temperature and noise standards and a
15 policy relating to air conditioning."
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 302A-1503, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:



1 "(b) In the case of equipment or fixtures that are to be
2 installed in existing or new school facilities, the department
3 [~~of accounting and general services~~] shall [~~thereafter~~] be
4 responsible for the repair and maintenance of the donated
5 equipment or fixtures. [~~In the case of equipment that supports~~
6 ~~the school's curriculum and programs, the department of~~
7 ~~education shall thereafter be responsible for the repair and~~
8 ~~maintenance of the donated equipment.~~]"

9 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
