# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DRIVER LICENSES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) The examiner of drivers may waive the knowledge test  
4 required under subsections (a) (2) and (a) (3) and the actual  
5 demonstration of ability to operate a motor vehicle for any  
6 person who is at least eighteen years of age and who possesses a  
7 valid driver's license issued to the applicant in any other  
8 state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the  
9 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of  
10 the Dominion of Canada, [œ] the Commonwealth of the Northern  
11 Mariana Islands, Republic of Palau, Federated States of  
12 Micronesia, and the Republic of the Marshall Islands for the  
13 operation of vehicles in categories 1 through 3 of section  
14 286-102."

15 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval;  
2 provided that the amendments made to section 286-108, Hawaii  
3 Revised Statutes, by this Act shall not be repealed when that  
4 section is reenacted on January 9, 2011, pursuant to section 15  
5 of Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005.
