## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSERVATION CORPS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that conservation corps, 2 such as Americorps and the department of land and natural
- 3 resources youth conservation corps, place participants in
- 4 natural resource conservation activities to assist them in
- 5 developing a sense of stewardship and enable them to gain
- 6 valuable work experience through community service, training,
- 7 and education. Generally, these programs are only available as
- 8 summer activities to students. A similar program for at-risk
- ${f 9}$  individuals in our community designed to assist them in
- 10 developing life and job skills to become responsible,
- 11 self-reliant citizens would be beneficial not only to these
- 12 individuals but to our communities and the State as well.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 14 land and natural resources to establish a two-year conservation
- 15 corps pilot program for the purpose of helping at-risk persons
- 16 to develop life and job skills and gain work experience. The

- 1 program shall be established in the county with the largest
- 2 contiguous land area in the State.
- 3 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
- 4 shall establish a Hawaii conservation corps pilot program in a
- 5 county with the largest contiguous land area in the State. The
- 6 program shall allow at-risk adults to serve in a conservation
- 7 program modeled after the Americorps program and the youth
- 8 conservation corps program. The program shall be designed to
- 9 focus on conservation and environmental protection, while
- 10 fostering work experience and life skills.
- 11 For purposes of this pilot program, "at-risk adult" is
- 12 defined to mean a person, aged eighteen years or older, who is
- 13 recovering from drug addiction or has recently been released
- 14 from prison and is reintegrating into the community.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) No later than twenty days prior to the
- 16 convening of the 2010 regular session of the legislature, the
- 17 department of land and natural resources shall submit a status
- 18 report of all its activities relating to the Hawaii conservation
- 19 corps program, including but not limited to:
- 20 (1) An accounting of all moneys received and disbursed;
- 21 (2) Detailed descriptions of the types of activities and
- 22 services offered to corps members;

4	(4)	Success rates in helping corps members find employment
5		or otherwise attain personal achievements and growth.
6	(b)	No later than twenty days prior to the convening of
7	the 2011	regular session of the legislature, the department of
8	land and	natural resources shall submit a final report of all
9	its activ	vities relating to the Hawaii conservation corps
10	program,	including all criteria from the initial report and
11	adding:	
12	(1)	The viability of continuation and expansion of the
13		program;
14	(2)	Whether the program should be made permanent; and
15	(3)	Any subsequent legislation that should be enacted to
