A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NEWBORN SCREENING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 321-291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§321-291 [Tests for phenylketonuria, hypothyroidism, and~~
4 ~~other metabolic diseases.] Newborn screening for certain~~
5 ~~diseases, disorders, and deficiencies.~~ (a) The department of
6 health [~~may~~] shall specify diseases, disorders, and deficiencies
7 to be screened for in newborn infants and methods to be employed
8 to best prevent mortality and morbidity within the population of
9 the State. Among the diseases, disorders, and deficiencies so
10 specified, the department shall also screen for:

- 11 (1) Defects of bipterin cofactor biosynthesis;
12 (2) Defects of bipterin cofactor regeneration;
13 (3) Dienoyl-CoA reductase;
14 (4) Galactose epimerase;
15 (5) Galactokinase;
16 (6) Medium/short chain L-3-hydroxy acyl-CoA dehydrogenase;
17 (7) Medium-chain ketoacyl-CoA thiolase; and
18 (8) Tyrosinemia type III."


