A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§26-52 Department heads and executive officers.** The
4 salaries of the following state officers shall be as follows:

5 (1) The salary of the superintendent of education shall be
6 set by the board of education at a rate no greater
7 than [~~\$150,000~~] \$_____ a year;

8 (2) The salary of the president of the University of
9 Hawaii shall be set by the board of regents;

10 (3) Effective July 1, 2004, the salaries of all department
11 heads or executive officers of the departments of
12 accounting and general services, agriculture, attorney
13 general, budget and finance, business, economic
14 development, and tourism, commerce and consumer
15 affairs, Hawaiian home lands, health, human resources
16 development, human services, labor and industrial
17 relations, land and natural resources, public safety,



1 taxation, and transportation shall be as last
2 recommended by the executive salary commission.
3 Effective July 1, 2007, and every six years
4 thereafter, the salaries shall be as last recommended
5 by the commission on salaries pursuant to section
6 26-56, unless rejected by the legislature; and
7 (4) The salary of the adjutant general shall be \$85,302 a
8 year. Effective July 1, 2007, and every six years
9 thereafter, the salary of the adjutant general shall
10 be as last recommended by the commission on salaries
11 pursuant to section 26-56, unless rejected by the
12 legislature, except that if the state salary is in
13 conflict with the pay and allowance fixed by the
14 tables of the regular army or air force of the United
15 States, the latter shall prevail."

16 SECTION 2. Section 302A-621, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 "**§302A-621 Salary; deputy superintendent, assistant**
19 **superintendents, complex area superintendents.** The salaries of
20 the deputy superintendent, assistant superintendents, and
21 complex area superintendents shall be set by the board; provided
22 that the salaries of the deputy superintendent, assistant




1 superintendents, and the complex area superintendents shall not
2 exceed [eighty] _____ per cent of the superintendent's salary."

3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
