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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTHCARE CLAIMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

- 1           SECTION 1. (a) There is established a health care claims  
2 uniform reporting and evaluation task force within the  
3 department of commerce and consumer affairs for administrative  
4 purposes, to consist of eleven members as follows:
- 5           (1) Six representatives from leading insurers, mutual  
6           benefit societies, fraternal benefit societies, and  
7           health maintenance organizations serving Hawaii  
8           residents, to be appointed by the insurance  
9           commissioner;
- 10          (2) The insurance commissioner or the commissioner's  
11          designee;
- 12          (3) The director of commerce and consumer affairs or the  
13          director's designee;
- 14          (4) Two physicians licensed and practicing in the state;  
15          and
- 16          (5) A representative from the John A. Burns school of  
17          medicine of the University of Hawaii.



1 (b) The members of the health care claims uniform  
2 reporting and evaluation task force shall elect a chairperson  
3 from among its membership.

4 (c) The health care claims uniform reporting and  
5 evaluation task force shall undertake a study to develop  
6 policies and procedures necessary to establish a health care  
7 claims uniform reporting and evaluation system and to ensure  
8 that the system is consistent with national claims reporting and  
9 evaluation standards.

10 (d) Members of the health care claims uniform reporting  
11 and evaluation task force shall serve without compensation and  
12 shall not be reimbursed for expenses.

13 (e) The health care claims uniform reporting and  
14 evaluation task force shall submit a report of its findings and  
15 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the  
16 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of  
17 the regular session of 2011.

18 (f) The health care claims uniform reporting and  
19 evaluation task force shall cease to exist on June 30, 2011.

20 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
