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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§302A-           Searchable budget database. (a) The  
5 department of education shall develop, maintain, and provide to  
6 the public, at no cost, a searchable budget database website  
7 that shall contain the following information:

8           (1) The amount and source of all moneys received by the  
9           department in an amount of at least \$5,000;

10          (2) Moneys expended by the department in an amount of at  
11          least \$1,000, including:

12          (A) The name and principal location or address of the  
13          entity receiving moneys; provided that  
14          information concerning a payment to an employee  
15          of the department shall identify the individual  
16          employee by position and business address only;  
17          provided further that, in accordance with section



1                   92F-12(a)(14), salary costs of employees shall be  
2                   disclosed as ranges of salary, rather than  
3                   specific salaries;

4                   (B) The amount of expended moneys;

5                   (C) The funding source of the expended moneys; and

6                   (D) The name of the budget program or activity  
7                   receiving the moneys.

8                   (b) The financial data shall be updated semi-annually and  
9                   provided in a structured format that may be downloaded. The  
10                   department shall archive the financial data, which shall remain  
11                   accessible and searchable for a minimum of five years. The  
12                   budget database website shall allow a website user to provide  
13                   feedback concerning the organization or utility of the website.

14                   (c) The budget database website shall be available to the  
15                   public no later than July 1, 2011, and shall contain only  
16                   information that is public record or that is not confidential or  
17                   otherwise protected from public disclosure pursuant to state or  
18                   federal law.

19                   (d) To the extent feasible, the department shall implement  
20                   the searchable budget database and the requirements of this  
21                   section as are financially practicable; provided that if the  
22                   department receives less than one hundred per cent of the



1 appropriation needed to completely carry out the purposes of  
2 this section in one fiscal year, then the department may  
3 establish and implement the searchable budget database in  
4 phases; provided further that the initial phase of the  
5 searchable budget database shall be completed and implemented no  
6 later than July 1, 2011.

7 (e) For the purposes of this section, "entity" means a  
8 corporation, association, union, limited liability company,  
9 limited liability partnership, grantee, contractor, local  
10 government, or other legal entity including a nonprofit  
11 corporation, and does not include an individual recipient of  
12 state public assistance or public assistance provided by the  
13 department of education."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
