A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$15,315,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2010-2011, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the seventh senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kilauea water system

9 Construction \$300,000

13 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 16 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 17 of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.


18 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 19 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
 20 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act as
 21 follows:



- 1 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
2 expended by the county of Kauai, department of water;
3 (2) The sums appropriated in items 6 through 9 shall be
4 expended by the county of Kauai; and
5 (3) The sums appropriated in items 10 and 11 shall be
6 expended by the department of education.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
