A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
12TH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2010-2011:

5 1. To be expended by the department of education:

6 A. Central middle school, Oahu

7 Design and construction for structural
8 repairs and restoration of buildings A,
9 B, and C due to termite damage.

14 Design, construction, and equipment for

19 chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.


