A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to change the manner
2 in which members of the stadium authority are appointed by
3 requiring the governor, the senate president, the speaker of the
4 house, and the president of the Aloha Stadium Swap Meet Vendors
5 Association to name appointments.

6 SECTION 2. Section 109-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

8 "(a) There shall be within the department of accounting
9 and general services for administrative purposes only, a stadium
10 authority whose responsibility shall be to maintain, operate,
11 and manage the stadium and facilities attached thereto and to
12 provide for the maintenance, operation, management, and
13 promotion of the Kapolei recreational sports complex. The
14 authority shall consist of nine members who shall be appointed
15 [~~by the governor in the manner prescribed by section 26-34.~~] as
16 follows:

17 (1) Four members shall be appointed by the governor;



- 1 (2) Two members shall be appointed by the senate
- 2 president;
- 3 (3) Two members shall be appointed by the speaker of the
- 4 house of representatives; and
- 5 (4) One member shall be appointed by the president of the
- 6 Aloha Stadium Swap Meet Vendors Association.


7 Each member of the authority shall have been a citizen of the
 8 United States and a resident of the State for at least five
 9 years next preceding the member's appointment. The president of
 10 the University of Hawaii and the superintendent of education
 11 shall be ex officio members of the authority but shall not
 12 vote."

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
