A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF IRRIGATION SYSTEMS WITHIN THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A reliable irrigation system is the lifeblood 2 of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To ensure that Hawaii's 3 crops receive a steady and dependable supply of water, 4 sufficient funding is needed to maintain and improve Hawaii's 5 irrigation systems. 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for capital 7 improvement projects for irrigation systems throughout the 8 State. 9 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue 10 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2009-2010 for the purpose of funding capital improvement projects for 13 14 irrigation systems throughout the State, as follows:

1	SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
2	improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5	unencumbered as of June 30, 2012, shall lapse as of that date.
6	SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
7	capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
8	department of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
9	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the irrigation
10	repair and maintenance special fund under section 167-24, Hawaii
11	Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for the purposes of
13	furthering the projects outlined in section 2 of this Act. Any
14	unexpended or unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by
15	this section as of the close of business on June 30, 2010, shall
16	lapse into the irrigation repair and maintenance special fund.
17	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
18	agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
19	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
