A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§201- Office of international affairs; special fund.

5 (a) There is established in the state treasury the office of
6 international affairs special fund.

7 (b) The following may be deposited into the office of
8 international affairs special fund:

9 (1) All revenues, admission fees, and charges from
10 workshops, seminars, conferences, trade shows, and
11 trade missions collected by the office of
12 international affairs; and

13 (2) Private or governmental grants, donations, and
14 contributions.

15 (c) Moneys in the special fund shall be used for the
16 following purposes:



- 1 (1) The planning, marketing, and implementation of
- 2 domestic and overseas workshops, seminars,
- 3 conferences, trade shows, and trade missions; and
- 4 (2) The performance of other duties of the office of
- 5 international affairs, including the promotion of
- 6 Hawaii business, trade, education, and culture."

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the office of

8 international affairs special fund established by section

9 201- , Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ or so

10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for

11 the purposes of the fund.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of


13 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of

14 this Act.
