SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT FUNDS BE MADE AVAILABLE AND RELEASED TO ENABLE
THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT A TENANT
MONITOR PROGRAM.

1 WHEREAS, when disturbances occur at public housing projects
2 and police officers are called to the premises, there is often
3 no single person with the proper authority and responsibility to
4 file complaints with the police officers or to handle the
5 situation; and

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7 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority has expressed
8 a desire to implement a tenant monitor program through which
9 resident managers would be available to address emergency repair
10 and security issues, serve as points of contact with the Hawaii
11 Public Housing Authority, and be responsible for communicating
12 with police officers when necessary; and

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14 WHEREAS, in order to implement a tenant monitor program,
15 the Hawaii Public Housing Authority requires resources to
16 establish resident manager positions; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Public Housing Authority desires to use
19 funds allocated for security in its public housing projects to
20 establish resident manager positions for the tenant monitor
21 program; now, therefore,

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23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fifth
24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2010,
25 that funds be made available and released to enable the Hawaii
26 Public Housing Authority to establish the necessary resident
27 manager positions to implement a tenant monitor program; and

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
2 Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director of the
3 Hawaii Public Housing Authority, the Governor, and the Director
4 of Finance.
