begs leave to report as follows:


Your Committee received testimony in support of this nomination from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs; a member of the State Boxing Commission of Hawai'i; USA Boxing, Inc.; Yeshua Boxing Club; the Kauai Police Activities League; and three private citizens. A personal statement and resume were received from the nominee. Written testimony presented to the Committee may be reviewed on the Legislature's website.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that the nominee's professional experience, commitment to public service, and proven leadership qualify him for appointment to the State Boxing Commission of Hawai'i. Your Committee notes that Mr. Kawano has been active in boxing for over twenty years, both as a boxer and a coach, and has taken the Hawaii State Champions to the National Championships since 1997.
