He retired from the Hawaii Army National Guard as a Colonel with experience in intelligence and disaster preparedness. The nominee is currently the President of Dallas Hawaii Investment, Inc., in Honolulu.

Your Committee believes that the nominee's experience as a battalion and deputy brigade commander along with his work with the Civil Defense Commission has provided him with a wealth of knowledge in disaster preparedness.

Your Committee notes favorably from the nominee's personal statement: "My prior experience as Chair of the Civil Defense




