Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 2052 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to enable the University of
Hawaii (UH) to retain the flexibility to use different sources of
UH funding to finance the establishment of new commercial
enterprises by repealing the sunset date for the provision that
allows UH to transfer certain funds into the UH Commercial
Enterprises Revolving Fund.

The UH System testified in support of this bill.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 2052 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be
referred to the Committee on Finance.
