Sir:

Your Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs,
to which was referred H.B. No. 2315 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII
SCHOOL OF TRAVEL INDUSTRY MANAGEMENT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the School of
Travel Industry Management (School) at the University of Hawaii
(UH) at Manoa retains its autonomous nature by statutorily
establishing the School as separate and independent of any school
or college of business administration also established at UH.

The Tourism Liaison and many concerned individuals testified
in support of this bill. UH at Manoa and Starwood Hotels and
Resorts Worldwide, Hawaii, and French Polynesia opposed this
measure.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to January 1, 2112; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs that is
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the



intent and purpose of H.B. No. 2315, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2315, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Higher Education.
