The purpose of this bill is to improve Hawaii's health care
system and expedite patient care by allowing pharmacists the
authority to administer immunizations to persons at least nine
years of age with parental consent.

Walgreen Co. testified in support of this bill. The Board of
Pharmacy offered comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2020.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
2464, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second
Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 2464, H.D. 1, and
be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
