Your Committee on Economic Revitalization, Business, &  
Military Affairs, to which was referred H.B. No. 2676 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE KAHO'OLAWA ISLAND RESERVE  
COMMISSION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to better facilitate the  
Kaho'olawe Island Reserve Commission's (KIRC) ability to carry out  
its statutory duties to protect, preserve, and rehabilitate the  
Island of Kaho'olawe by exempting contracts made by KIRC for the  
procurement of food or fuel products from the state procurement  
code.

KIRC testified in support of this bill. The State  
Procurement Office opposed this measure.


Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Requiring KIRC to continue to comply with the reporting  
requirements of the state procurement code for contracts  
entered into under this exemption;
- (2) Changing the effective date to January 1, 2112, to  
encourage further discussion; and
- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,  
consistency, and style.
