Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 2688
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to increase the amount that the
Environmental Health Education Fund (EHEF) may accumulate before
transferring the excess into the general fund; and allow the funds
to be used for sanitation programs. This bill also changes the
name of the EHEF to the Sanitation and Environmental Health Fund.

A concerned individual testified in support of this bill.
The Department of Budget and Finance opposed this measure. The
Department of Health provided comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
2688 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be referred to
the Committee on Finance.
