Your Committee on Labor & Public Employment, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 102 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR ENFORCEMENT OF EXISTING OSHA REGULATIONS ON THE USE OF HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM AND URGING OSHA TO DEVELOP SAFER ALTERNATIVES AND BAN HEXAVALENT CHROMIUM,"

The purpose of this resolution is to express support for the enforcement of existing OSHA regulations on the use of hexavalent chromium and urging OSHA to develop safer alternatives and ban hexavalent chromium.


