Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred
H.C.R. No. 13 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE
HOME FOR LIFE TASK FORCE TO REPORT ON ITS FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REDUCING BARRIERS TO AGING IN PLACE AND

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to extend the deadline for the
Home for Life Task Force to report on its findings and
recommendations for reducing barriers to aging in place and
facilitating multigenerational living.

Testimony in support of this measure was submitted by the
Disability and Communication Access Board, the Kokua Council, and
the Hawaii Chapter of the American Physical Therapy Association.
Written testimony presented to the Committee may be reviewed on
the Legislature's website.

Your Committee finds that the Home for Life Task force was
created to perform the important function of coordinating and
researching ways to reduce barriers to aging in place and
multigenerational or accessible living. The intent in creating
the Task Force was to allow our kupuna to age in place to the
greatest extent possible and to spend quality time with their
families in their golden years. This measure will also benefit
persons with disabilities who face similar barriers as they strive
to "live in place." It is important to the people of Hawaii that
all of these individuals be treated with respect and dignity, and
