As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Public Safety and Military Affairs and Transportation, International and Intergovernmental Affairs that

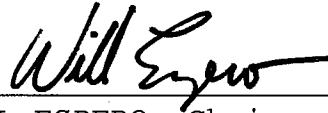


are attached to this report, your Committees concur with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 175, and recommend its adoption.

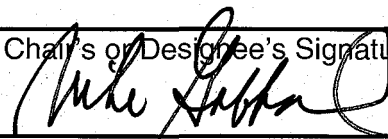
