Your Committee on Human Services, to which was referred  
H.C.R. No. 61 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO  
PERFORM A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE CHILD SUPPORT  
ENFORCEMENT AGENCY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this concurrent resolution is to request the  
auditor to perform a financial and management audit of the Child  
Support Enforcement Agency.


The Attorney General provided comments on this measure.

Your Committee finds that the Child Support Enforcement  
Agency has one of the highest caseload to caseworker ratios in the  
nation. In order to ensure that the Child Support Enforcement  
Agency is fulfilling its purpose of helping families by promoting  
self-sufficiency, your Committee finds that an audit is necessary  
in finding ways to reduce the caseworker to caseload ratio.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your  
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 61 and  
recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Legislative  
Management.
