Your Committee on Economic Revitalization, Business, &
Military Affairs, to which was referred H.R. No. 154 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF
DEFENSE FOR HEALTH AFFAIRS OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
DEFENSE TO REVISE THE PRIORITIES FOR ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE AT
MILITARY HEALTH FACILITIES TO GIVE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL
GUARD WHO ARE INJURED IN ANY DUTY STATUS THE SAME PRIORITY AS
ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY MEMBERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to recognize the active
duty service of National Guard members by requesting the Assistant
Secretary of Defense for Health Affairs of the United States
Department of Defense to revise the priorities for access to
health care at military health facilities to give members of the
National Guard who are injured in the line of duty while in any
duty status the same priority as active duty military members.


Oahu Veterans Council supported this resolution.

others with wounds and injuries. As they are injured in the line
