Your Committees on Education and Labor & Public Employment,
to which was referred H.R. No. 192 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE GOVERNOR, THE BOARD OF
EDUCATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, AND THE HAWAII STATE
TEACHERS ASSOCIATION TO REOPEN NEGOTIATIONS TO REDUCE
FURLOUGH FRIDAYS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this resolution is to strongly urge the
Governor, the Board of Education (BOE), and the Hawaii State
Teachers Association to return to the bargaining table to reopen
negotiations with the intent to reduce furloughs and increase
instructional days.

BOE, the state representative from the 19th Representative
District, and several concerned individuals testified in support
of this measure.

Your Committees suggest that rather than accept the current
furlough schedule as the only viable option, the department
consider alternative schedules including school breaks.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Education and Labor & Public Employment that are
attached to this report, your Committees concur with the intent
and purpose of H.R. No. 192 and recommend that it be referred to
the Committee on Finance.
