Your Committee on Housing, to which was referred H.R. No. 87
entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION URGING THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO SEEK
REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR
HOMELESS SERVICES PROVIDED IN HAWAII TO MIGRANTS UNDER THE

The purpose of this resolution is to urge the United States
government to seek reimbursement from the Federated States of
Micronesia for homeless services provided to migrants in Hawaii
who have entered the state through privileges provided under the
Compact of Free Association (COFA).

Several concerned individuals testified in support of this
concurrent resolution.

Your Committee has amended this resolution by:


- (1) Deleting language referring to homeless services so that
the request applies to all services provided to COFA
migrants;
- (2) Changing the title to read: "URGING THE UNITED STATES
GOVERNMENT TO SEEK REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE FEDERATED
STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR SERVICES PROVIDED IN HAWAII TO
MIGRANTS UNDER THE COMPACT OF FREE ASSOCIATION"; and



- (3) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.R. No. 87, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance in the form attached hereto as H.R. No. 87, H.D. 1.
