Your Committee on Labor, to which was referred S.B. No. 2175
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE EMPLOYER-UNION HEALTH
BENEFITS TRUST FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require that one public
employer member on the Board of Trustees of the Employer-Union
Health Benefits Trust Fund be appointed by the Hawaii Council of
Mayors to represent the counties.

Comments on this measure were submitted by one private
organization. Written testimony presented to the Committee may be
reviewed on the Legislature's website.


Your Committee finds that the counties contribute a
substantial amount to the Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust
Fund and the health and well-being of their employees and retirees
depend on the benefit decisions made by the Board of Trustees.
Your Committee also finds that having a county representative
serve on the Board of Trustees will provide the Board with insight
into the fiscal and employment concerns that pertain to each
respective county.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing the
effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion
on this measure.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Labor that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2175, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2175, S.D. 1.
