Sir:

Your Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs,
to which was referred S.B. No. 2601, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ATHLETIC TRAINERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to regulate the practice of
athletic training by requiring athletic trainers to register with
the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA).

The Occupational Therapy Association of Hawaii testified in
support of this bill. The Department of Education, Hawaii Chapter
- American Physical Therapy Association, and Hawaii Athletic
Trainers Association supported this measure with amendments.
DCCA's Professional and Vocational Licensing Division and the
University of Hawaii System provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by deleting its contents
and replacing it with provisions that require the State Auditor to
conduct a sunrise analysis of the licensure of athletic trainers.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Tourism, Culture, & International Affairs that is
attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the
intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2601, S.D. 1, as amended herein,
and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached



hereto as S.B. No. 2601, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, and be referred to the
Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
