<u>SB 2236, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR2465)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES. Establishes fines for failing to pay, bill, or remit the inspection, quarantine, and eradication fee. Effective 7/1/2050.	AGR, JUD
<u>SB 2523, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR2466)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL INSPECTIONS. Exempts bulk freight of foreign origin from the inspection, quarantine, and eradication service fee and charge; effective 7/1/50. (SD2)	AGR, FIN

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

The following measure(s) were previously heard on **Friday, March 12, 2010**.

<u>SB 2527, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR2338)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Amends the definition of "agricultural commodity" to include milk, eggs, poultry, and livestock of the bovine, equine, swine, sheep, or goat species and the carcasses or meat of those species. Takes effect 7/1/2050. (SD2)	AGR, FIN


