HB 2288  
Status

RELATING TO PRIVATE TRANSFER FEES.  
Prohibits the imposition of fees for a future transfer of real property.  
Specifies exceptions.

HB 2905  
Status

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.  
Prohibits use by minors of false identification to purchase liquor.  
Establishes fines and other penalties. Designates 50% of revenues  
from fines to county programs for underage drinking awareness and  
prevention. Authorizes the issuance of citations as an alternative to  
arrest for violations associated with intoxicating liquor.


