<u>HB 2131</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO GASOLINE DEALERS. Requires gasoline dealers to provide access to water at no cost to customers who purchase motor vehicle fuel.	EBM, CPC/JUD
<u>HB 2057</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT. Requires a purchasing agency to hold a pre-bid conference. Requires parties that protest a contract award to have attended a pre-bid conference.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2058</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY. Amends definition of the term "concession" to remove telecommunications operations. Exempts telecommunications operations from the Hawaii public procurement code.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2133</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Amends the Hawaii public procurement code to make public contracts effective as of the notice of the award. Specifies that the solicitation, offer, bid, or proposal and the award notice constitute the entire contract. Provides that a subsequent written and executed contract is not required.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2283</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT. Requires government purchasers to follow ethical principles in matters relating to procurement.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2438</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Clarifies requirements for adequate public notice of an invitation for bids and request for proposals.	EBM



<u>HB 2443</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Imposes sixty day period in which to certify contracts after award of contract of procurement.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2901</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Establishes special procedures for requests for competitive sealed proposals for design-build projects.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2413</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Amends the State private investment fund to direct its investment capital to venture capital funds that commit to equity investments in businesses located within the state and demonstrate ability to mentor entrepreneurs; Authorizes \$     in tax credits to be used by the fund as collateral.	EBM, FIN
<u>HB 2945</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Directs the state private investment fund's investment capital to venture capital funds that commit to equity investments in businesses located within the State and demonstrate an ability to mentor entrepreneurs. Also authorizes an unspecified amount in tax credits to be used by the fund as collateral.	EBM, FIN


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
