Status

RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER PROGRAM.

EEP/EBM, FIN

Amends the definition of "deposit beverage" to include wine and hard spirits.

HB 2209
Status

RELATING TO ENERGY INNOVATION AWARDS.

EBM/EEP, FIN

Establishes the energy innovation award to be awarded by the high technology innovation corporation to applicants that present patentable technologies that create significant energy savings for Hawaii.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
